Booking your holiday

If you would like further information or advice, or would like to check availability, please contact one of our sales agents. They will be happy to reserve a boat in your name for up to 48hrs. To confirm your reservation, all you need to do is return a signed booking form and a **35% deposit**.

After booking your holiday you will receive a new information pack containing a DVD, a guide to cruising, maps and a Captain's Manual which includes information about the services we offer, boat handling procedures and safe boating advice. You can also buy a more detailed Waterways Guide specific to your region, or check out our website for further information about your cruising area.

One-way cruises

No other company is able to offer the freedom and flexibility of one-way cruising like Le Boat. One-way cruises are available from most of our bases, but please note there is a **£67** one-way supplement fee payable on all bookings.

If you are travelling by car to your departure base, you can request a car transfer where your car is delivered to your finishing point by the time you end your cruise. If a car transfer is not available, then we can arrange a taxi to transfer your party back to the start base.

Please note that one-way cruises must be for a minimum of one week, unless you are cruising from Castelnaudary – Trèbes (or vice versa).

Short Breaks

Why not take advantage of a long weekend or enjoy a mid-week break? You can book a short break to cruise at any time before **16/06/08** or after **19/09/08**. Short breaks are also possible during the summer season depending on availability. Summer short breaks can be booked up to 4 weeks before departure – please contact us for further details. Extra nights are subject to availability. Please note that a supplement of **£100** will be charged if you cruise over a Bank Holiday Weekend. For short breaks, your boat will be ready for collection from **16.00** onwards on the day of departure and you must return the boat by **09.00** on the final day.

Short break prices are calculated as follows:
3 nights / 2 days = 55% of the weekly hire price
4 nights / 3 days = 65% of the weekly hire price
5 nights / 4 days = 75% of the weekly hire price

Priority Check-in

Normally our boats are ready from 16:00 onwards on the day of departure. However, subject to operational constraints, it may be possible for you to collect your boat between 12:00 midday and 13:00, giving you an extra afternoon's cruising. If you plan to be in the area before 16:00 and would like to have your boat earlier, please highlight on your booking form and contact the sales team one week prior to departure. They will liaise with the base and confirm if an early check-in will be possible. **An additional fee of £50 is to be paid locally.**

Late Check-Out Service

Normally our boats have to be returned to the base by 09:00 on the final day of your holiday. However, subject to operational constraints it may be possible for you to delay returning your boat until 12:00 midday, giving you an extra morning's cruising. If you would like to take advantage of this service, please liaise with the base on arrival. **An additional fee of £50 is to be paid locally.**

Extended cruises

Many of our customers like to book cruises lasting nine nights or more. These are priced pro-rata based on the number of nights on board. Call the sales team if you would like to book an extended cruise.

Terms of booking

Discounts are for the areas listed above. They can only be taken on cruises of 1 week or more. Discounts can be combined up to a maximum of 15%.

Damage Waiver

All our boats are fully covered for damage and damage to other property or vessels for claims over £1,000. All our boats are covered fully for third party liability.

Option 1 – The refundable damage deposit

On arrival at the base, you leave a refundable deposit of £1,000 which will only be exercised if the boat or any of its equipment / inventory is returned damaged or lost, or in the case of any accidental damage to third parties. This will not be the case if there is evidence of gross neglect, which is excluded from our cover under our insurance policy.

Option 2 – The non-refundable damage waiver*

A charge of between £55 - £111 can be paid on arrival or at the time of booking. With this option you will be fully covered if the boat or any of its equipment / inventory is returned damaged or lost, as well as if there is any accidental damage to third parties. This will not be the case if there is evidence of gross neglect, which is excluded from our cover under our insurance policy.

* In certain instances we may insist on a deposit rather than the waiver

Calculating the cost of your holiday

Week or Fortnight

All our prices shown in the following tables are based on a 7-night duration and are a per-boat price. Cross-reference the dates of your holiday with the type of boat you have chosen. Your boat will be ready for collection from 16.00 onwards on the day of departure and you must return the boat by 09.00 on the final day.

Short Breaks and Weekends

Short break prices are calculated as follows:

3 nights / 2 days = **55%** of the weekly hire price

4 nights / 3 days = **65%** of the weekly hire price

5 nights / 4 days = **75%** of the weekly hire price

Extra nights are subject to availability. Please note that a supplement of **£100** will be charged if you cruise over a Bank Holiday Weekend.

Longer cruises

Longer cruises lasting 9, 10 or 11 nights are available from all bases, which are priced on a pro rata basis, based on the number of nights you want to take.

To cancel your cruise we will require written confirmation from the party leader. The postmark date is the date on which the cancellation becomes effective. Please refer to the table below for our cancellation/amendment terms and conditions.

*Note: If changing from a return trip to a one way trip, the one way fee of £67 is also applicable.

Major changes made by you less than 55 days prior to departure may be viewed as cancellation. Major changes will include, without limitation, those scenarios set out in the table above.

If you have taken out our travel insurance and the reason for cancellation is within the scope of the insurance, then the deposit or balance of the hire may be reclaimed from Townergate Chase Parkinson.

5. Cancellation - If we cancel or amend your holiday

Sometimes we may have to make a major change to your booking, this would include, but is not limited to, change of cruising area, change of departure date and change of boat to a lesser model. If we have to make a major change to your holiday we will:

- Offer you an alternative holiday to the same or better standard (where available)
- Offer you a lesser holiday and a refund of the difference in price (where available); or
- Cancel your holiday and give you a full refund of all monies paid excluding any insurance premiums paid to us.

In addition we will pay compensation if appropriate, but not where the major change has occurred due to an event of Force Majeure or because there were insufficient bookings to operate a particular base.
Force Majeure means unusual and unforeseeable circumstances beyond our control, the consequences of which could not have been avoided even if all due care had been exercised. Examples of Force Majeure are listed in clause 22

We strongly recommend you provide us with an emergency contact telephone number in case of any unexpected changes that need to be made to your holiday at short notice.

6. Insurance

Le Boat has comprehensively insured the boat and its equipment. The policy covers damage or loss to the boat and its equipment and also no less than £7m third party liability. This policy extends to cover any incident caused by the Hirer or the Hirer's crew. This policy is included in the cost of your holiday

The policy in place has certain reasonable exclusions to cover as a result of certain actions by the Hirer or the Hirer's crew. These include willful damage or gross negligence, person being under the influence of drugs or alcohol or as result of not obeying the instructions of a member of Le Boat staff. If the insurer fails to indemnify Le Boat because of the above then the Hirer is responsible for all costs. Adults will at all times be responsible for the minors in their care.

Le Boat's insurance does not cover the Hirer's personal belongings. We strongly recommend that you take out our travel insurance – a summary of the insurance that we offer is included in these terms and conditions. If you do not require our travel insurance we will ask you to sign and complete an insurance indemnity form with your alternative insurance policy details.

7. Damage Waiver

Insurers charge Le Boat an excess with every incident and also the cost of claims potentially forces up the premiums we pay. To encourage a duty of care from you, the Hirer, and to contribute to covering this cost we ask you to pay either:

Option 1: Refundable damage deposit

On arrival at the base, you leave a refundable damage deposit (£1000) which will only be exercised if the boat or any of its equipment / inventory is returned damaged or lost, as well as costs of any accidental damage or injury to any third parties. This will not be the case if there is evidence of gross neglect, which is excluded from our cover under our insurance policy.

Option 2: Non-refundable damage waiver

A charge of between £55 and £111 can be paid on arrival or at the time of booking. With this option you will be fully covered if the boat or any of its equipment / inventory is returned damaged or lost, as well as costs of any accidental damage or injury to any third parties. This will not be the case if there is evidence of gross neglect, which is excluded from our cover under our insurance policy. These charges do not alter the Hirer's potential liability outlined in the insurance paragraph above.

8. Embarkation/Disembarkation and Cruising Route

Boat embarkation time is usually from 16:00 on your start day and disembarkation must be by 09:00 on the return day. A boat briefing and local cruising brief will be conducted before you depart the base. The Company reserves the right to make changes to the times/and or direction of the cruise. Minor changes will not entitle the Hirer to cancel with a refund or compensation.

9. Prices

The prices quoted in the brochure are based on costs, exchange rates, taxes and levies as known at July 2007.

The price of your travel arrangements may be subject to surcharges for increases in:

i). Transportation costs e.g. fuel.

ii). Dues taxes or fees chargeable for services e.g. landing taxes

Any benefits derived from decreases in these costs will be passed to you. In the case of any small variation, an amount equivalent to 2% of your travel arrangements, which excludes insurance premiums and any amendment charges, will be absorbed or retained. For larger variations this 2% will still be absorbed for increases but not retained from refunds. No price increases will be made within 30 days of departure.

In either case there will be an administration charge of £1 (or equivalent) per person together with an amount to cover any agents' commission. If this means that you have to pay an increase of more than 10% of the price of your travel arrangements you may cancel and receive a full refund minus any amendment charges.

10. Navigational Restrictions

Our brochure offers a number of cruising suggestions for each region based on our experience and knowledge of the area. At the start of your cruise, you will receive a Waterways Guide and/or detailed cruising notes for your region, clearly stating which waterways are navigable and which are prohibited or restricted. The base team will also advise on any specific routes, which are prohibited or restricted, or procedures falling under the control of the National Inland Waterways Authorities. Our guarantee does not cover cruising in areas that are prohibited or restricted. Please contact the sales team prior to departure if you wish to cruise on any waterways not covered in our brochure.

11. Accidents and Loss of Equipment

If the boat is involved in an accident of any nature, the Hirer must immediately contact the base and complete an accident report form (found on board) and ask any other party involved to complete the same form. The Hirer will not ask for any repairs to be carried out without Le Boat's agreement. Should any equipment be lost, stolen or broken, the Hirer must report this on their return of the boat.

12. Bicycle Theft Waiver

This weekly charge of £7 or two week charge of £10 can be booked and paid for on arrival. With this option you will be fully covered if the bicycle is stolen.

13. Technical Assistance

Le Boat has a breakdown service during normal working hours every day of the week. We will endeavour to attend and repair a breakdown or technical incident as quickly as possible. The Hirer will have no claim against Le Boat for any failure caused by the hirer including but not limited to grounding, and in such instances the company will reserve the right to recover from the Hirer the expenses incurred in rectifying the matter.

14. Security Deposit

Before departing the base on board your cruiser, you will be required to leave a Security Deposit. This deposit is towards the cost of the following incidentals:

Fuel Charges (See fuel charges)

Cleaning Fee (See return of the boat)

Grounding Fee – Charged if you ground the boat and assistance was required.

Damage to or loss of bicycles

This is in addition to the Non-refundable Damage Waiver or Refundable deposit mentioned in clause 7

15. Return of the boat

The boat must be returned by 09:00 on your final day at the correct base, unless you have booked a late check out. Late returns will incur an abandonment fee of £330. We expect the boat to be returned reasonably clean, i.e. with all bedding stripped, rubbish neatly bagged and all crockery and utensils cleaned. If the boat is left in an unsatisfactory condition a cleaning fee of between £52 and £65 will apply dependent on the type of boat.

16. Fuel Charges

In France, Belgium, Holland, Italy and Germany, Le Boat charges the amount of hours the engine has been running. At the start of your cruise you will be informed how much the per hour charge will be and the current engine hours on your boat will be agreed and recorded with you.

In Ireland, England and Scotland, Le Boat charges fuel by the litre. At the start of your cruise the boat will be handed to you with a full tank of fuel and you will be informed by the staff member how much your fuel will cost per litre.

17. Your security - Limitations on our liability

Where you have booked a package holiday (as defined in the Package Travel, Package Holiday and Package Tours Regulations 1992) through Le Boat then we will accept responsibility for the proper performance of our obligations under this contract. We will perform such obligations with reasonable skill and care. We are not responsible for any failure that is attributable to you or a member of your party; attributable to a 3rd party unconnected with the provision of services to you and is unforeseeable and unavoidable; or due to Force Majeure.

Our liability to you for any loss or damage which you may suffer is limited to three times the price of your holiday. This excludes personal injury resulting from the non-performance or improper performance of the services involved in the holiday, and is subject to the limitation of liability described below. Health and safety standards applicable to the services provided by us under this contract should meet the local standards applicable to your holiday destination.

18. Air Travel Conditions of Carriage

You must comply with the conditions of carriage applied by land, sea and air carriers. The provisions of the Warsaw Convention 1929 (as amended) concerning the carriage of passengers and their luggage by air, and the airlines' conditions of carriage, may apply to you and your party during your flight, and during boarding and disembarkation. These provisions and conditions may limit or exclude liability for death or personal injury, or loss of or damage to luggage, and may make special provisions for valuables. We will supply a copy of the conditions of carriage applicable to your flight, and of the Warsaw Convention, if you request them.

NOTICE OF LIABILITY LIMITATIONS

This is a notice required by European Community Regulation (EC) No. 889/2002. This notice cannot be used as a basis for a claim for compensation, nor to interpret the provisions of the Montreal Convention or the Regulation. It does not form part of the contract between the carrier(s) and you and no representation is made as to the accuracy of the contents of this notice.

Compensation in the case of death or injury

There are no financial limits to the liability for passenger injury or death. For damages up to 100000 SDRs (approximately £80,000) the air carrier cannot contest claims for compensation. Above that amount, the air carrier can defend itself against a claim by proving that it was not negligent or otherwise at fault.

Advance payments

If a passenger is killed or injured, the air carrier must make an advance payment, to cover immediate economic needs, within 15 days from the identification of the person entitled to compensation. In the event of death, this advance payment shall not be less than 16000 SDRs (approximately £13,000).

Passenger delays

In case of passenger delay, the air carrier is liable for damage unless it took all reasonable measures to avoid the damage or it was impossible to take such measures. The liability for passenger delay is limited to 4150 SDRs (approximately £3,300)

Baggage delays

In case of baggage delay, the air carrier is liable for damage unless it took all reasonable measures to avoid the damage or it was impossible to take such measures. The liability for baggage delay is limited to 1000 SDRs (approximately £800).

Destruction, loss or damage to baggage

The air carrier is liable for destruction, loss or damage to baggage up to 1000 SDRs (approximately £800). In the case of checked baggage, it is liable even if not at fault, unless the baggage was defective. In the case of unchecked baggage, the carrier is liable only if at fault.

Higher limits for baggage

A passenger can benefit from a higher liability limit by making a special declaration at the latest at check-in and by paying a supplementary fee.

Complaints on baggage

If the baggage is damaged, delayed, lost or destroyed, the passenger must write and complain to the air carrier as soon as possible. In the case of damage to checked baggage, the passenger must write and complain within seven days, and in the case of delay within 21 days, in both cases from the date on which the baggage was placed at the passenger's disposal.

Liability of contracting and actual carriers

If the air carrier actually performing the flight is not the same as the contracting air carrier, the passenger has the right to address a complaint or to make a claim for damages against either.

If the name or code of an air carrier is indicated on the ticket, that air carrier is the contracting air carrier.

Time limit for action

Any action in court to claim damages must be brought within two years from the date of arrival of the aircraft, or from the date on which the aircraft ought to have arrived.

Basis for the information

The basis for the rules described above is the Montreal Convention of 28 May 1999, which is implemented in the Community by Regulation SP. (EC) No 2027/97 (as amended by Regulation (EC) No 889/2002) and national legislation of the Member States.

In accordance with EU directive (EC) No 2111/2005, Article 9, we are required to bring to your attention the existence of a "Community List" which contains details of air carriers that are subject to an operating ban within the EU Community. The Community list is available for inspection at <http://air-ban.europa.eu>

19. Sea and Rail Conditions of Carriage

When you book your travel with a carrier, the conditions of that carrier will apply, some of which limit liability. Clients should note carefully that such conditions include clauses limiting or excluding liability in respect of injury, loss or damage. All members of the party subject to the carrier's terms and conditions. This brochure is issued on the sole responsibility of Le Boat. It is not issued on behalf of, and does not commit the carriers mentioned, or any carrier whose services are used in the course of the holiday. Any cancellations by the Hirer may incur charges levied by the carrier for which you will be responsible.

20. Hirer's suitability

The Hirer's must accept responsibility for the proper conduct of him/herself and any members of their party. Le Boat cannot be held responsible for under age consumption of alcohol. We reserve the right in our absolute discretion to terminate without further notice the holiday arrangements of any client who refuses to comply with the instructions or orders of the company staff, agent or other responsible person whose behaviour in their opinion is likely to cause distress, damage or danger or annoyance to other customers, staff, any third party or to property. Upon such termination our responsibility for your holiday ceases and we shall not be liable for any extra costs incurred by you.

21. Boat Descriptions

Boat layout plans, specifications and illustrations in the brochure are general guidance. Some models within boat classes have minor variations.

22. Force Majeure

We regret we cannot accept responsibility for or pay any compensation where performance or prompt performance of our contract with you is prevented or affected by reason of circumstances amounting to 'Force Majeure'. Such circumstances include, but are not limited to: the destruction or damage of your boat through fire, flood, explosion, storm or weather damage; accidental damage; criminal damage or any other force outside of our control. These also include flooding, shortage of water, obstruction, repairs to any waterway, lock or navigational equipment, shortage of or non availability of fuel, riots or civil strife, industrial action or nuclear disaster, fire, adverse weather conditions, port blockades, war or threat of war, and actual or threatened terrorist activity or similar.

23. Law and Jurisdiction

This agreement will be governed by English law and any disputes will be dealt with by the English Courts. If however you booked your holiday in Scotland or Northern Ireland any disputes may be dealt with in the local courts in Scotland or Northern Ireland and will be subject to the law of those countries.

24. Complaints

If you have a complaint whilst you are on holiday, please inform the base manager or a Le Boat office immediately so that remedial actions can be taken. If you wish to make a claim against us then you must notify us in writing within 35 days of your return home by writing to our Customer Relations department at our Port Solent address.

Disputes which cannot be amicably settled, may (if you so wish) be referred to the arbitration under a special scheme which, although devised by arrangement with the Association of British Travel Agents, is administered quite independently by the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators.

25. Dogs

Dogs can be taken on Le Boat holidays. We do make a charge for taking dogs and we ask you to bring a basket/blanket for the dog to sleep on. Animals are not allowed to lie on bedding or settees. Please do not leave dogs unattended on your boat. If the base feels extra cleaning is required on the return of your boat, you will be asked to pay the cleaning fee.

26. Data Protection

To ensure that your holiday runs smoothly, we need to use information such as your name and address, special needs, dietary requirements, etc. We will apply appropriate security measures to protect this data. However, we must pass it to suppliers of your travel arrangements, including airlines, hotels and transport companies. We may also supply it to security or credit checking companies, and to public authorities such as customs and immigration. If your holiday is outside the European Economic Area (EEA), controls on data protection in your destination may not be as strict as in the UK. We will only pass data, including sensitive information regarding disabilities or dietary and religious requirements, to people responsible for your travel arrangements. If we cannot pass this information to the relevant suppliers, in the EEA or elsewhere, we cannot provide your booking. When you make this booking, you consent to this information being passed to the relevant people. We can supply a copy of your information held by us; there is a small charge for providing this. We may use this information to contact you with details of other products and services offered by Le Boat companies.
